Brief Introduction to FAIRHAP

In January 2017, a consortium of five partners from Greece, Romania, Bulgaria, Latvia and Italy joined the project entitled “Fair Play and Happiness through Sports (FAIRHAP)”.

FAIRHAP is a two years project, co-funded by the European Commission under the Erasmus+ programme.

The project’s context is to provide the necessary awareness to those who teach sports to children about basic Olympic values and support sport teachers, P.E. teachers and coaches, who teach sports to children, through innovative educational seminar approaches, in order to facilitate the transferring of values together with the joy through sports.

The objective is to instil and teach children, at an age that is most vital to the development of character and personality, all the universal values that are concentrated in the Olympic ideals, through participation in sports activities, using a specially formulated educational material.

DESK RESEARCH REPORT

The 1st FAIRHAP output has been released on 31st August, 2017. This is the e-report entitled: *Needs for Education on Fair Play and Olympic Ideals*.

The report contains:

- analysis of the current situation in the partner countries regarding sport system;
- analysis of the current status of awareness raising about sports ethics among sports educators;
- analysis of ethics in sports and social implications - Sports for all as a tool for social change and personal growth;
- analysis of sport participation for children and its effects on social progress and personal growth;
- description of the educational needs of sports' teachers and coaches regarding the promotion of Olympic ideals;
- composite information on Good Practices and innovative approaches.

FIELD RESEARCH REPORT

The 2nd FAIRHAP output has also been released on 31st August, 2017. This is the e-report, which presents the results of an exploratory survey in the 5 Partners' countries titled: *Attitudes regarding social and moral values of sport/P.E. teachers and coaches*.

The main objectives of this study were to:

- Explore the concepts that Physical Education (PE) Teachers, Sport teachers and Coaches adopt regarding values.
- Explore how sport/P.E. teachers and coaches define, understand and facilitate the potential contribution of sports to the development of Olympic values through teaching social and moral skills to their pupils,
- Identify the resources/training sport/P.E. teaches and coaches draw on to obtain their knowledge about promoting Olympic values, social and moral skills development,
- Identify sport/P.E. teaches' and coaches' possible needs regarding new educational tools and approaches for the promotion of fundamental Olympic values.

VALIDATION WORKSHOPS

The FAIRHAP partners are now involved in the organization of a validation workshop that should be organized in all countries involved in the FAIRHAP project by the responsible partners.

Through this workshop, the Desk and Field research reports should undergo a validation process with the relevant stakeholders of the project in each partner's country.

DEVELOPMENT OF EDUCATIONAL MATERIAL

The FAIRHAP partners are now also involved with the production of appropriate educational material for the sports teachers, PE teachers and coaches that will be trained through this project in order to help them teach the children about the principles of the FAIRHAP Project. The educational material is being developed taking into consideration a series of different sections, each shall contain different content, procedures, and other information, arranged in a logical sequence and broken down into small units. Besides the theoretical material the partnership will also develop training session plans to be used by the sports teachers during the following training activities of the project.



Kick-off & 2nd meeting

The project partnership had its first successful meeting in Athens (GR), on 19th-20th of January 2017. The partnership agreed on the roles of each partner and on the general terms as well as the specific tasks.

The second meeting was held in Jelgava (LV), on 28th and 29th of June, 2017. Following a productive 6-month project period that started with the kick-off meeting in Athens, the partners met and discussed the progress of the tasks of the project that have been implemented and the results that have been achieved.
