## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

On December 10, 2018 in the Hall of the Teachers' House in Haskovo a FAIRHAP "Happiness through Sport" Conferencing Conference was organized and held. The conference was invited to attend public, sportsmen, representatives of the RMS, physical education teachers and parents. The project, launched in January 2017 in a consortium of five partners from Greece, Romania, Bulgaria, Latvia and Italy "Fair play and happiness through sport (FAIRHAP)" is a two-year project co-funded by the European Commission under the Erasmus + . The aim of the project was to support and educate those who teach children's sport about basic Olympic values through innovative educational approaches and to facilitate the transfer and penetration of values combined with the joy of gaming to 10-12 year olds through sport. The project has implemented its activities and achieved its objectives:

- Improving the understanding of Olympic fundamental values and their importance and the ability to apply and promote these concepts in all aspects of children's lives.
- Allows children to participate in team sports, increase their cognitive, emotional and psychomotor activity and develop their self-awareness, sense of interdependence, cooperation and collegiality.
- Changing the attitude of sports organizations and institutions, coaches and sport teachers in their future work.
- Mobilize people directly involved in sports, education, schools, amateur clubs and mass sports organizations to expand their awareness of the importance of promoting the Olympic values.

## 2. DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT

---

All invitees were invited with the official logo of the project. Those who accepted the invitation were 30 people who signed a letter of consent for the participation and protection of personal data. The participants were registered in the attendance list just before the start of the activity report, debates, discussions and questions. The purpose of the event is to take into account the results achieved, validate the event and take the advice and recommendations of coaches and sports teachers, citizens and parents through outgoing surveys. At the end of the final conference each participant was awarded a certificate from the project.

The conference was held on 10.12.2018 from 9.00 am to 1.30 pm in Haskovo, District Center in the Teacher's Home building. The conference was opened by Mrs. Iliyana Pavlova - project manager from the Inter Sport Group "Haskovo". There were 5

speakers, including 2 moderators and 2 assistants, who are all members of the hall, multimedia, catering and logistics.

The hall was attended by 30 people from the Municipality of Haskovo, Rousse Haskovo, directors of sports schools, coaches, physical education teachers, media representatives, presidents of sports clubs.

### 3. DISCUSSION & RESULTS

---

The conference was opened by Mrs. Iliana Pavlova and a short presentation of all the activities of the FAIRHAP project was made. The moderators distributed promotional materials to the participants in the work program. the director of the sports school "Vidlicka Micina" from the sports schools presented the results they have seen from the trainings and the training of their coaches and children's teams. The benefit of such projects and future partnerships is discussed.

Mrs. Dimitrina Naydenova - coach made a report on the work of the 6-month coaches, the benefits and the open tournament at the end of the training. Recommendations were given for more start-up training for coaches and sports teachers in the future, as training materials and periodic trainings are not sufficient. Through a brainstorming conducted by moderators through interactive activities, it was found that project outcomes have a public response, change of thinking and The project will be sustainable over time with upgrading activities on the ground.
