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FINAL CONFERENCE FOR THE DISSEMINATION OF RESULTS

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1. INTRODUCTION

The event – The National FairHap Conference – was carried out according to planning, on November 23rd, 2018, in the Senate Hall, in the A Building of Alexandru Ioan Cuza University Iași. 84 persons – most of them teachers and coaches – attended the event. In addition, we highlight the presence of renowned specialists in Medicine and Psychology who had presentations and interventions referring to the means and methods used within the project. The assessment of the Fairhap project and of its outcomes was featured, and the conclusions disseminated after the centralization of the results. Representatives of newspapers, TV and radio were also present.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THE EVENT

The persons invited to the event were selected according to several criteria: coaches participating in the project; teachers and coaches interested in the idea of the project, lecturers within the academia, school inspectors, and the press.

The event took place on November 23rd, 2018, in the Senate Hall, in the A Building of Alexandru Ioan Cuza University Iași, in the interval 3 pm – 6 pm (The FairHap Conference) and 6 pm – 7 pm (FairHap workshop).

School Inspector Sorin Popovici: Promoting the Olympic values in school: New trends.

At the end of each presentation, the public asked questions and the organizers provided explanations.

In addition, ways were proposed to continue the project activities locally, by increasing the number of participants and of the educational establishments involved, as well as by diversifying sports and action means.

We believe it is necessary to engage the press and the local community more in order to promote the Olympic values among all members of the population (students, adults, minorities).

This project may be continued by applying another form of implementation to include a greater number of participating countries and to be carried out over a longer period.

3. DISCUSSION & RESULTS

The findings within the project were presented and analyzed.

The main discussion concerned the ways to continue and develop the project.

In addition, discussions were intensified within the FairHap workshop conducted between 6 pm and 7 pm, in the same location. This event included coaches involved in the project and the members of the FairHap team in Iași (Romania).

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4. PROMOTION OF THE EVENT

The conference was presented in the media before the event through: press release (the Media Department of UAIC Iași), posters. The guests of the event included representatives of the local media, and the conference was promoted on several channels (UAIC website, Viva FM, Evenimentul Zilei newspaper, TVR Iași).

The participants to the conference received the following: flyers with the project logo, notebooks, memory sticks, pens, certificate of participation. The memory units offered comprised information about the FairHap project.

The event also included a coffee break and it ended with catering services.

5. CONCLUSION

We believe that both the project and the final conference were successful in all regards. The feedback from participants, children, parents and representatives of the local community stands to prove the aforementioned statement.
